COMMENTS OF NATIONAL
LIFELINE ASSOCIATION

The National Lifeline Association (NaLA) respectfully submits to the Oregon Public Utility Commission (Commission) its comments on the December 24, 2025 Notice of Proposed Rulemaking with Statement of Need and Fiscal Impact and Proposed Rules (NPRM) in Docket AR 675.¹ NaLA represents wireless Lifeline service providers operating in Oregon, or seeking to operate in Oregon, as well as other parts of the Lifeline ecosystem, including distributors, that can be critical to connecting low-income Oregonians with Lifeline services. NaLA appreciates the opportunity to comment on the NPRM and to work with Commission staff on an appropriate combination of monthly reimbursement and service levels to be offered to Lifeline-eligible households in Oregon that will attract multiple competing Lifeline providers to Oregon to better meet the connectivity needs of eligible low-income Oregon residents.

NaLA limits its comments on the NPRM to the proposed changes to Administrative Rule 860-033-0035 regarding the federal and Oregon Lifeline benefits. The proposed change to Administrative Rule 860-033-0035 is confusing and seemingly misguided because it would

increase the Oregon Lifeline reimbursement amount from \$10.00/month to \$15.00/month only for subscribers that pay a monthly rate for Lifeline service and not for those that receive Lifeline service at no charge. The Commission should reconsider that proposed change and increase the reimbursement amount to \$15.00 for all Oregon Lifeline subscribers, including those low-income households that cannot afford a monthly charge and receive service at no cost. Moreover, NaLA proposes that the Commission eliminate the requirement in the rules to provide unlimited voice and data for customers that receive Lifeline service at no charge. As with the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP), there is no need for a minimum service standard (MSS) if you have multiple service providers competing to offer Lifeline services to eligible households.

I. THE COMMISSION SHOULD INCREASE THE OREGON LIFELINE REIMBURSEMENT AMOUNT FROM \$10.00 TO \$15.00 FOR ALL LIFELINE ELIGIBLE LOW-INCOME HOUSEHOLDS IN OREGON

The NPRM explains that House Bill 3148 increased the limitation on expenditures, which authorized the Commission to increase the Oregon Lifeline reimbursement amount from \$10.00 to \$15.00.² The NPRM’s “proposed rule amendments adjust the Oregon Lifeline subsidy to \$15.00 for customers who pay a monthly rate.”³ The redlined changes to Administrative Rule 860-033-0035 reflect that change from \$10.00 to \$15.00 in (1)(b) “for customers paying a monthly rate” but does not reflect an increase in (1)(c) “for a customer that receives Oregon Lifeline supported services at no charge.”⁴

The Commission should modify Administrative Rule 860-033-0035(1)(c) to reflect the increase in monthly reimbursement amount from \$10.00 to \$15.00 for customers that receive Lifeline supported service at no charge. Low-income households that cannot afford and who otherwise lack the means to pay a monthly rate for voice and/or broadband service, and therefore seek out a “no charge” Lifeline service are the most in need of support. Half of Lifeline subscribers surveyed by NaLA indicated that they are unbanked⁵ and therefore do not have a credit card to use to make monthly payments. They should receive the largest available subsidy so that they can receive a service plan with the most voice minutes and gigabytes of data.

Lifeline service providers can provide more robust service offering bundles of minutes and data when they receive additional subsidies for discounts off retail plans. If a \$24.25 subsidy is available (\$15.00 Oregon Lifeline + \$9.25 federal Lifeline), a service provider can provide more minutes and data than if a subsidy of only \$19.25 (\$10.00 Oregon Lifeline + \$9.25 federal Lifeline) is available. That is why Lifeline service providers offer more robust Lifeline service plans to Lifeline customers in California and where additional support is available for residents of Tribal (and former Tribal) lands.⁶ California provides an additional monthly subsidy of \$19.00 and federal Tribal Lifeline offers additional monthly support of up to \$25.00. Both are available to subscribers regardless of whether they pay monthly for their Lifeline service plan or receive the discounted service at no cost.

II. MINIMUM SERVICE STANDARDS ARE UNNECESSARY BECAUSE LIFELINE PROVIDERS WILL COMPETE AND INCREASE SERVICE OFFERS BASED ON THE TOTAL SUBSIDY AMOUNT

Proposed Administrative Rule 860-033-0035(1)(c) regarding Lifeline services offered at no charge to low-income customers requires the provider to offer unlimited voice minutes for basic service and unlimited data for any broadband internet access service provided to the customer, and provides only a \$10.00 monthly reimbursement. Contrarily, (1)(b) of the rule regarding customers that pay a monthly rate provides support of up to \$15.00, but does not impose a service offering obligation.

Imposing MSS for Lifeline service is unnecessary and can be counterproductive to the Lifeline program's goals if set too high. The federal Lifeline program has imposed annually increasing MSS since 2016 (which increases have been waived for years due to an ill-conceived formula) and, by contrast, the far more successful Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB) and ACP were established without any MSS. The federal Lifeline program, with its stagnant and paltry monthly reimbursement and unrealistic MSS untethered to affordability, has a participation rate of approximately 21 percent,⁷ which is far below a rate that would reflect a program that spurs participation by a majority of those households eligible for it. By contrast, at its peak of serving 23 million low-income households out of 53 million eligible, the ACP had a 44 percent participation rate.⁸ That participation success was driven primarily by the higher monthly reimbursement amount and competition free of rate regulation such as an MSS.

If the Commission does set an Oregon Lifeline MSS, it should set it for monthly paid plans and no cost plans alike. Moreover, the Commission should seek only to set a floor (an actual minimum) to weed out low-value plans, and not seek to set the market. An unlimited voice and data requirement is not a floor and could not be provided by most Lifeline providers for a total reimbursement of \$24.25 (\$15.00 Oregon Lifeline + \$9.25 federal Lifeline). In fact, the Commission had to grant i-wireless a waiver of the unlimited voice and data requirement in August 2022 due to equity and affordability concerns because i-wireless had indicated it could no longer provide free handsets.⁹ The Commission and i-wireless agreed that i-wireless would provide unlimited voice minutes and 5 GB data with a free phone.¹⁰ Therefore, it should be evident to the Commission that unlimited voice and data is an unrealistic MSS.

The Commission need not set an MSS, but rather should allow multiple Lifeline providers to compete for subscribers. The NaLA 2025 Prepaid Mobile Broadband Price Survey¹¹ can help to indicate the types of plans that service providers are likely to offer to Oregon Lifeline subscribers based on the retail marketplace. **For a total reimbursement of \$24.25, wireless service providers are likely to offer bundled plans with unlimited voice, unlimited text and between 5 GB and 8 GB data.** For example, Consumer Cellular offers unlimited voice, unlimited text and 1 GB data for \$25.00; US Cellular offers unlimited voice, unlimited text and 2 GB for \$25.00; boom! Mobile offers unlimited voice, unlimited text and 3 GB data for \$25.00; LightMobile and Optimum both offer unlimited voice, unlimited text and 5

GB for \$25.00; Ultra Mobile offers unlimited voice, unlimited text and 8 GB data for \$24.00; Walmart Family Mobile offers unlimited voice, unlimited text and 8 GB data for \$24.88; and Simple Mobile offers unlimited voice, unlimited text and 15 GB data for \$25. Excluding the outliers like Consumer Cellular at 1 GB, US Cellular at 2 GB and Simple Mobile at 15 GB for \$25.00, most providers with a \$25.00 plan offer unlimited voice, unlimited text and between 5 GB and 8 GB data. That is approximately what the Commission should expect competition to produce for Oregon Lifeline subscribers without imposing a MSS.

CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission should increase the Oregon Lifeline reimbursement for customers that receive Lifeline service at no charge from \$10.00 to \$15.00 to be consistent with the reimbursement for customers that pay a monthly rate. In addition, the Commission should not impose any MSS for Oregon Lifeline because it can expect competition to result in robust bundled service offerings for low-income Oregon households.
