Re: Docket No. PCN 5 – In the Matter of Idaho Power Company’s Petition for Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity.

Dear ALJ John Mellgren,

As you will recall, at our discovery conference yesterday, Greg Larkin committed to providing Idaho Power with electronic copies of selected portions of his medical records by the end of the day today. In turn, Idaho Power Company (“Idaho Power” or “Company”) agreed to review these records with its consultant and notify the Commission as to whether the documents satisfied Idaho Power’s need for medical information from Mr. Larkin. Earlier this afternoon Mr. Larkin filed a document that stated that he would file his medical documents as soon as he received direction as to how to file them confidentially. Importantly, Mr. Larkin requested that the medical records be made available only to Idaho Power’s attorneys, and to you, the hearings officer.

Idaho Power understands the need for sensitive handling of Mr. Larkin’s records and its obligation to comply with the Standard Protective Order under which they are being provided. However, as I explained at the discovery conference, the Company cannot determine whether to pursue the additional medical records it requested without sharing the ones produced with its consultant and the personnel at Idaho Power who are working on this issue. And given that Idaho Power must make a decision by tomorrow afternoon as to whether the documents are sufficient, I had planned to send them to the consultant and at least one Idaho Power representative (in addition to its in-house counsel) at the end of the day today, so that we can discuss them at a meeting scheduled for tomorrow at noon.

For the above reasons, Idaho Power asks that, in the event Your Honor wishes to direct Idaho Power not to send the medical records to its consultant and to Idaho Power representatives, that Your Honor do so by the end of the day.
