**RE: Docket No. UG 519 – Compliance Filing**

This electronic filing is a Compliance Filing pursuant to Order No. 25-198 in Docket No. UG-519. The stipulation adopted in Order No. 25-198 states:

*“As a part of the stipulation, Avista commits to additional outreach to identify additional multi-family customers as addressed in CUB testimony. Any customers identified as multi-family will be moved to Schedule 411 immediately. The multi-family deferral will continue to ensure that the movement of additional existing customers to rate schedule 411 will be revenue neutral to Avista. The company will file an update six months after the conclusion of this case discussing the number of customers and other relevant data for customers moved to Schedule 411.”*

Additional multi-family households were identified by searching the Company’s customer address information in our customer billing system for key words like (Unit, Apt, Suite, ext.). Through this process, Avista identified an additional 1,439<sup>1</sup> customers who fit the definition of a multi-family residence. These customers were moved from residential schedule 410 to residential multi-family schedule 411 on September 1, 2025.

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<sup>1</sup> CUB testimony identified 3,409 additional customer households thought to possibly be multi-family. The majority of the difference between the number identified by CUB and the actual number identified by the Company are mobile homes that don’t fit within the definition of a multi-family unit.
