PacifiCorp dba, Pacific Power (“the Company”) hereby submits for filing proposed tariff pages to cancel Schedule 193, Transition Plan-Oregon Regulatory Asset Adjustment. Concurrent with this filing, the Company is making a compliance filing in Docket UM 1012 with the Company’s proposal to amortize the balance associated with the reduction of the regulatory fees for 2010. The Company has proposed to apply the UM 1012 balance as an offset to the current balance for Schedule 193. As a result of this offset, Schedule 193 will be fully recovered by August 1, 2010. Any over collection of the balance will be transferred to the Miscellaneous Deferred Accounts balancing account.

Schedule 193 originally went into effect in February 2010 in compliance with Order 10-022, which adopted the stipulation in the Company’s general rate case in Docket UE 210. Accordingly, the Company is providing notice of this filing to the service list in UE 210.

This filing results in an overall decrease of 0.2 percent. A residential customer using 900 kWh per month would see a bill decrease of \$0.14 per month as a result of this change.

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
