Second Revision to Compliance Filing to UM 1129 Order No. 06-538

Dear Sir or Madam:

On November 3, 2006, Idaho Power Company (“Idaho Power” or the “Company”), in accordance with Order No. 06-538 entered by the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (“OPUC” or the “Commission”) on September 20, 2006, submitted under Advice No. 06-10, its Energy Sales Agreement (both on-system and off-system Standard Contract) and filed its revised Schedule 85, “Cogeneration and Small Power Production Standard Contract Rates”, Sheet Nos. 85-1 and 85-3 through 85-9. This filing was a revision of the original compliance filing, dated October 20, 2006, where the Company had, through a misunderstanding, omitted submitting the “off-system” version of the Standard Contract.

On November 13, 2006, the Commission, in Order No. 06-627, suspended Advice No. 06-10 for a period of time not to exceed six month from November 20, 2006, in order to investigate the propriety and reasonableness of the tariff sheets pursuant to ORS 757.210 and 757.215. That investigation is now complete and the Company has revised its on-system and off-system Standard Contracts to address the compliance issues which were in question.

Please note that Section 7.4 in both the on-system and off-system Standard Contracts has been revised to correct an error in the formula used to determine Shortfall Energy prices.

Therefore, Idaho Power now respectfully requests that the on-system Standard Contract and the off-system Standard Contract submitted on November 3, 2006 be completely replaced with the attached on-system Standard Contract and off-system Standard Contract. Schedule 85, “Cogeneration and Small Power Production Standard Contract Rates”, Sheet Nos. 85-1 and 85-3 through 85-9, submitted with the November 3, 2006 filing, remain unchanged.

In accordance with OAR 860-013-0070, Idaho Power waives service by means other than by electronic mail. Consistent with that waiver, Idaho Power respectfully requests that the following receive notices and communications in respect to this matter:
