RE: UM 1484 CenturyLink's Petition to Remove Condition Requiring Reporting of DSL Subscribers and DSL Trouble Reports

Dear Commission:

On May 31, 2013, consistent with the terms of Condition 55 of Order No. 11-095 in the above entitled matter, CenturyLink filed a petition to remove the condition requiring reporting of DSL subscribers and DSL trouble reports. In discussions with Commission Staff since the filing of that petition, Staff requested CenturyLink file additional reports of DSL subscribers and DSL trouble reports containing the information specified in Condition 55 for the period September 2012 through July 2013. Attached on the enclosed CD disk are confidential reports which provide information on CenturyLink's DSL subscribers and DSL trouble reports in Oregon for the period requested by Staff.

Staff also requested information on the number of requests for DSL service that CenturyLink was unable to fulfill because broadband had not yet been made available in the area. CenturyLink respectfully notes that it does not separately track requests for DSL service that it is unable to fulfill, and therefore it does not have information available to respond to Staff's request.
