The Oregon Citizens' Utility Board ("CUB") files this Notice of Intent to Request Issue Fund Grants in AR 603, pursuant to OAR 860-012-0100(3)(a) and the Third Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement ("IFA"), approved by the Oregon Public Utility Commission ("Commission") in Order No. 15-335 (October 20, 2015). AR 603 is also an eligible proceeding under the 2016-2020 Intervenor Funding Agreement ("IPCO IFA") between Idaho Power Company and the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, as approved by the Oregon Public Utility Commission in Order No. 16-028 (January 26, 2016).

- The Public Utility Commission of Oregon has opened a docket to explore issues related to implementing the community solar provisions of SB 1547.
  The Commission will examine this filing in Docket No. AR 603.
- 2. AR 603 is an Eligible Proceeding under the IFA and the IPCO IFA. Both IFA's defines an Eligible Proceeding as "any Commission proceeding that directly affects one or more of the Participating Public Utilities." IFA, Article 1(c); IPCO IFA, Article 1(b).
- 3. AR 603 will directly affect PacifiCorp, Portland General Electric (PGE), and

Idaho Power, which are Participating Public Utilities under Article 1(k) of the IFA.

4. As required by Article 6.2 in both the IFA and IPCO IFA, this Notice of Intent is being served on each affected Participating Public Utility, all pre-certified organizations, and all parties identified on the service list from AR 603.

5. CUB identifies the 2017 PacifiCorp Issue Fund Account, the 2017 PGE Issue Fund Account, and the 2017 Idaho Power Issue Fund Account as the accounts from which CUB intends to request the Issue Fund Grants.

6. CUB has been pre-certified under Article 5.2(a) of the IFA, Article 5.1 of the IPCO IFA, and OAR 860-001-0120(3)(a), as eligible to receive an Issue Fund Grant.

7. CUB will file a proposed budget with respect to the Issue Fund Grant, as provided in Article 6.3 of both the IFA and IPCO IFA.
