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Pursuant to Section 6.7 of the Fourth Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement (“IFA”), as approved by the Oregon Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) in Order No. 18-017, entered January 17, 2018, the Oregon Citizens’ Utility Board (“CUB”) hereby files this Request for Amendment of Proposed Budget in Docket No. UE 390. CUB seeks an increase of \$30,000 to its approved Issue Fund Grant in this proceeding, for a new grant in the amount of \$55,000.

CUB filed a Request for an Issue Fund Grant and Proposed Budget in Docket No. UE 390 on April 13, 2021, request a grant in the amount of \$25,000. On April 22, 2021, the Commission approved CUB’s proposed budget in Order No. 21-114. CUB is now requesting an amendment to its authorized budget.

Article 6.7 of the IFA states that *“At any time during the proceeding, an intervenor who received Commission approval for an Issue Fund Grant may file to amend its budget and request additional funding due to unforeseen changes in the scope or complexity of issues, position taken by other parties, changes in the schedule of the case, or other good cause.”*

CUB seeks approval to amend its authorized budget to accommodate the increased costs of CUB’s participation in this proceeding.

Therefore, CUB respectfully requests that the Commission issue and order granting CUB's Request for Amendment of its Proposed Budget in this Proceeding.
