Pursuant to Section 7.3 of the Fourth Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement (“IFA”) approved by the Oregon Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) in Order No. 18-017 (January 17, 2018), the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers (“AWEC”) hereby requests final payment of AWEC’s approved Issue Fund Grant in Docket No. UE 400 in the amount of \$18,428.12.

On March 16, 2022, AWEC filed a Request for Issue Fund Grant and Proposed Budget in Docket No. UE 400, showing eligible expenses in the amount of \$23,035.15 and requesting an Issue Fund Grant in the amount of \$18,428.12. The Commission issued Order No. 22-149 on May 4, 2022, approving an Issue Fund Grant for AWEC in the amount of \$18,428.12. At this time, AWEC requests that the Commission authorize final payment of AWEC’s approved Issue Fund Grant in Docket No. UE 400 in the amount of \$18,428.12 from the 2022 PacifiCorp Issue Fund. AWEC’s expenses are shown in Confidential Exhibit A.

This Request for Payment satisfies the requirements of the IFA as follows:

Section 7.3(a) – The itemized expenses, payees, and hourly rates are attached as Confidential Exhibit A.

Section 7.3(b) – AWEC was an active participant in this Docket. AWEC reviewed the filings in this docket, conducted discovery, filed testimony, and participated in settlement discussions. The expenses included in Confidential Exhibit A are reasonable and directly attributable to AWEC’s participation in UE 400.

Section 7.3(c) – The Commission approved AWEC’s proposed budget on May 4, 2022. In addition, AWEC used its own funds to pay for at least 20% of the Eligible Expenses as required by Section 6.5 of the IFA.

Section 7.3(d) - This Request for Payment constitutes a Final Request for Payment in this Docket.

Section 7.4 – All of the expenses included in Exhibit A are Eligible Expenses as defined in Section 7.4 of the IFA because they relate to services provided or expenses incurred by AWEC’s outside legal counsel and expert witnesses. Relevant non-privileged documents substantiating the Eligible Expenses in Confidential Exhibit A are available for Commission audit, if requested, pursuant to Section 7.10 of the IFA.

The IFA provides that the granting of an Issue Fund Grant “shall constitute a binding obligation on the Commission to order reimbursement of Eligible Expenses.” IFA § 6.5. Likewise, the intervenor funding rules adopted by the Commission provide that “[t]he terms of an [intervenor funding] agreement are binding on all organizations seeking a grant under that agreement and will be followed by the Commission in administering the agreement.” OAR § 860-001-0120(2). AWEC has satisfied the terms of the IFA and respectfully requests that the Commission approve final payment of AWEC’s Issue Fund Grant in the amount of \$18,428.12 from the 2022 PacifiCorp Issue Fund within 30 days of receiving this Request for Final Payment, as provided in Article 7.6 of the IFA.
