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Pursuant to Section 7.3 of the Fourth Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement (“IFA”) approved by the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (“Commission”) in Order No. 18-017 (January 17, 2018), Alliance of Western Energy Consumers (“AWEC”) hereby requests payment of AWEC’s Issue Fund Grant in Docket No. UG 366 in the amount of \$31,673.40, which after AWEC’s 20 percent match, is \$25,338.72. In support of this request, AWEC shows the following:

1. On May 10, 2019, AWEC, f/k/a Northwest Industrial Gas Users (“NWIGU”), filed a Proposed Issue Fund Budget in the amount of \$65,375 less in-house resources of 20 percent, for a total grant request of up to \$52,300. However, the uncommitted balance in Avista’s Issue Fund Account was only \$45,681.98 at the time, and of that amount, AWEC requested \$38,000 as its maximum grant amount. The Commission approved the Issue Fund Grant in the amount of \$38,000 on May 14, 2019.

2. After engaging in discovery, filing detailed testimony, and multiple settlement conferences, the parties were able to settle this proceeding. AWEC hereby

requests that the Commission authorize payment of the approved Issue Fund Grant in this docket in the amount of \$25,338.72 (\$31,673.40 minus 20 percent). AWEC's Eligible Expenses for this proceeding through October 2019 are shown in Confidential Attachment A.

3. AWEC respectfully submits that this request for payment satisfies the requirement of IFA Section 7.3 as follows:

Section 7.3(a) - The itemized expenses, payees and hourly rates are attached as Confidential Attachment A.

Section 7.3(b) - AWEC was a full and active participant in this docket. AWEC and its consultants participated in discovery in this proceeding, participated in informal meetings and telephone conferences with Avista, Staff, and/or CUB, and participated in settlement workshops and discussions, as well as drafting testimony, editing the stipulation and joint testimony in support of the stipulation. The expenses included in Confidential Attachment A are Eligible Expenses as defined in IFA Section 7.4 and are reasonable and directly attributable to AWEC's participation in UG 366 on behalf of all customers.

Section 7.3(c) - The only condition of the Issue Fund Grant is that AWEC must contribute 20% of Eligible Expenses using in-house resources. AWEC used its own funds to pay for at least 20% of the Eligible Expenses as required by Section 6.5 of the IFA.

Section 7.3 (d) - This request is a request for final payment of the approved issue fund in this docket.

4. Section 7.4 – All of the expenses included in Confidential Attachment A are Eligible Expenses as defined in Section 7.4 of the IFA and are consistent with AWEC’s proposed budget in this proceeding.

5. Upon approval of this request for payment by the Commission, Avista should send payment to AWEC as follows:

6. AWEC has satisfied the terms of the IFA and respectfully requests that the Commission approve payment of AWEC’s Issue Fund Grant in the amount of \$25,338.72 (\$31,673.40 minus 20 percent), from the Avista Issue Fund within 30 days of receiving this Request for Payment as provided in Section 7.6 of the IFA. With this payment, the remainder of the approved Issue Fund Grant can be released.
