

Denying Motion for Additional Protection

Dear Judge Smith:

Applicants have reached a settlement with Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU) and Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB) regarding disclosure of the list of the Texas Pacific Group's Limited Partners (*i.e.*, the investor or "customer" list). This was the last issue requiring resolution that was the subject of Applicants' Motion Requesting Certification of Judge Smith's Ruling filed on June 7, 2004. Accordingly, Applicants withdraw their motion. The parties have agreed that, in the event CUB or ICNU determine at some time in the future that they do require a copy of the investor lists, they may file another motion and renew their request; at that point, Applicants will rejoin the issue whether the ALJ properly decided their original Motion for Additional Protection.
