STATUS REPORT

Investigation into Large Customer Energy
Efficiency Limitations.

This investigation has been held in abeyance while the parties discuss possible legislative solutions to the issues presented in this docket. On August 6, 2015, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) directed Staff to file a status report regarding the stakeholders/parties' efforts in coming to agreement regarding a legislative proposal.

Staff reports that the stakeholders/parties intend to meet on November 5, 2015, to determine whether they can agree to a legislative proposal. Staff asks the ALJ to set November 13, 2015, as the due date for the next status report. By that time, Staff should be able to report on whether a legislative solution is still a viable option and whether a prehearing conference should be scheduled to establish a procedural schedule for this docket.
