

Dear UM 1930 Stakeholders,

Below is the schedule for major policy decisions related to UM 1930 Community Solar Program (CSP) Implementation. The decisions under consideration are as follows:

- Interconnection: solutions to ensure that CSP interconnections are fair and functional.
- Bill credit
 - Implementation of the Simple Retail Rate
 - Transition after the interim capacity tier
- Low income participation requirements
 - Minimum eligible low-income participants per-project (%)
 - Requirements for LI participation fees
 - Definition of eligible low-income participant
- Transition between start-up and ongoing costs
 - Transition point
 - Administrative fee methodology

This schedule balances the need to establish certainty of key project design elements before pre-certification launches in November/December 2019, while ensuring there is enough time for Stakeholders to respond to the proposal.

Date	Activity
Monday, Aug. 26, 2019	Staff follow-up workshop on interconnection proposals.
Friday, September 6, 2019	Staff previews the PA Team's proposal for bill credit, transition between start-up and ongoing, and low-income program policy issues, to provide Stakeholders sufficient time to develop comments on the October 1, 2019 memo.
Tuesday, October 1, 2019	Staff Memo with final recommendations for interconnection, bill credit, transition between start-up and ongoing, and low-income program policy issues.
Thursday, October 15, 2019	Deadline for Stakeholder written comments on Staff memo.
Tuesday, Oct. 22, 2019	Regular Public Meeting: Staff presents final policy recommendations and Stakeholders have the opportunity to comment.
Tuesday, Oct. 29, 2019	Special Public Meeting: Commission deliberate and decide policy issues.
