Clean Energy Plans are required to include a “risk-based examination of resiliency opportunities that includes costs, consequences, outcomes and benefits based on reasonable and prudent industry resiliency standards and guidelines established by the Public Utility Commission.” The U.S. Department of Energy’s Grid Modernization Laboratory Consortium (GMLC) is helping support this requirement by developing a report on industry resiliency standards and practices for electric-sector planning. This workshop will present the GMLC’s initial research into industry standards and practices and invite feedback, including additional research questions and areas of focus.
