Jennie,

I have been recently informed by Mel Kroker that the water line coming to their house from the MHWD's water distribution system continues to receive MHWD water. While the initial thought was that this may be just residual water in the water line beginning at the point where it had allegedly been disconnected from the MHWD's meter, such a conclusion was readily dismissed after the Krokeros let the water line down to their house run for four hours on two separate occasions over the course of two consecutive days with no resulting visible reductions in flow.

With the understanding that it is approximately 1,000 linear feet from **Point "A"** (representing where the MHWD's 6" water main connects to the line from the MHWD well house) to **Point "B"** (representing where the MHWD's meter for the water line down to the Krokeros' house is located off the 6" water main), the MHWD's 6" water main would hold nearly 1200 gallons. Therefore, even if the MHWD did not disconnect the water line down to the Krokeros' house at its meter as it should have, but rather, at or near the MHWD well house, that line should have emptied in less than two hours, and certainly in less than eight. It of course did not. Thus, it appears not only did the MHWD not disconnect the water line down to the Krokeros' house at the downstream side of the MHWD's meter located off the MHWD's 6" water main, but that the MHWD likely did not disconnect it at all. Regardless, I again request that the MHWD disconnect the water line down to the Krokeros' house from the MHWD distribution system per their original request and, therefore, at the downstream side of the MHWD meter.

Once such disconnection has been properly completed at the downstream side of the MHWD meter, please provide written confirmation of the same. Should you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.
