Reply Comments by Pacific Power	November 12, 2013	November 26, 2013


In addition, the Company requests that the ALJ temporarily suspend the remainder of the procedural schedule (which includes the Public Utility Commission of Oregon Staff (Staff) and intervenor final comments, Company final comments, and Staff's proposed order and final recommendation). The Company will work with parties to this proceeding to develop and file a subsequent motion to adopt a modified procedural schedule by November 26, 2013. The Company contacted all of the parties to this proceeding on November 5, 2013 to inquire as to their position on the proposed amendment to and temporary suspension of the procedural schedule. As of the time of filing, no parties oppose this motion.

The proposed schedule allows the Company two additional weeks to submit reply comments. The additional time will enable the Company to more fully respond to the comments received from the Commission and Staff at the October 28, 2013 public meeting.

The Company believes that parties will benefit by receiving reply comments that are as responsive as possible to concerns raised at the above-mentioned public meeting.

Under OAR 860-001-0420(7), PacifiCorp requests expedited consideration of its request to amend and temporarily suspend the schedule. PacifiCorp requests that the ALJ provide for a ruling on this motion by November 11, 2013, prior to the current due date for the Company's reply comments.

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
