COALITION’S MOTION FOR  
EXTENSION OF TIME  
  
EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION  
REQUESTED

The Renewable Energy Coalition (the “Coalition”) hereby moves the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (the “Commission”) Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) for an extension of time for Staff and Intervenors to file Comments in this proceeding. Specifically, the Coalition requests that the deadline is moved from March 4, 2021 to March 10, 2021. The Coalition also proposes other changes to the subsequent schedule to accommodate this change, as follows:

The Coalition attempted to confer with other parties prior to filing this motion, and the motion is unopposed by all parties that stated a position as of the time of filing. NewSun Energy, LLC, Renewable Northwest, and the Northwest & Intermountain Power Producers Coalition support the motion. Portland General Electric Company (“PGE”), Commission Staff, the Citizens Utility Board, and Northwest Energy Coalition do not oppose the motion. As of the

time of filing, the Coalition has not yet received a response from the Alliance for Western Energy Consumers or Swan Lake North Hydro LLC.

The purpose of the requested extension is to provide sufficient time for Portland General Electric Company (“PGE”) to respond to the Coalition’s outstanding data requests and for the Coalition to review the data responses, which are necessary for the Coalition to prepare its comments in this proceeding. PGE has represented that it expects to provide the data responses by March 8, 2021, which will provide the Coalition with two business days to file its comments on March 10, 2021. If PGE is not able to provide all of the data responses by March 8, 2021, or if the data responses are not adequate for the Coalition to prepare its comments, the Coalition may seek additional time. The Coalition did not solicit positions from the other parties on any future request and understands that the other parties may take the same or different positions on any future motion.
