MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL
SCHEDULE

9 Staff of the Public Utility Commission (“staff”), the Citizens’ Utility Board (“CUB”), and
10 the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities ask the administrative law judge to modify the
11 procedural schedule in the above-captioned docket as described below. Because the next event
12 in the procedural schedule is February 11, 2008, staff, CUB and ICNU request expedited
13 consideration of this motion. Portland General Electric Company (“PGE”) has been notified of
14 the proposed schedule change and does not oppose it. PGE also does not oppose the request for
15 expedited treatment.

16 Staff and intervenor testimony is currently due on February 11, 2008, with PGE reply
17 testimony due on March 14, 2008, and a hearing scheduled for April 3, 2008. Staff, CUB, and
18 ICNU ask that the administrative law judge modify the schedule as follows:

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Event	Date
Staff and intervenor testimony	February 20, 2008
PGE reply testimony	March 24, 2008
Hearing	April 14, 2008 (or if ALJ not available, on a date agreeable to ALJ and parties)

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25 Staff, CUB, and ICNU ask for this extension because the issues in the case are complex
26 and all three parties need additional time to conduct discovery and draft testimony.


1 **CONCLUSION**

2 For the foregoing reasons, staff, CUB, and ICNU ask the administrative law judge to
3 amend the procedural schedule in Docket No. UE 196 as described above.
