MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEDURAL
SCHEDULE TO ALLOW FILING OF
STIPULATION

8 Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (“staff”) requests that the procedural
9 schedule in this matter be modified to allow the parties opportunity to finalize and file a
10 stipulation resolving all issues in the case. The procedural schedule currently calls for a hearing
11 on April 7, 2009. The parties to the docket, staff, Idaho Power Company (“Idaho Power”), and
12 the Citizens’ Utility Board (“CUB”), have agreed in principle on the appropriate resolution of all
13 issues in the docket. Accordingly, it is not necessary to proceed with the hearing scheduled for
14 April 7, 2009, or with any post-hearing briefing.

15 The parties reached an agreement resolving all issues in the docket today, April 1, 2009.
16 The parties anticipate that they can file a stipulation and supporting documents on April 20,
17 2009. Staff asks that the administrative law judge modify the procedural schedule by removing
18 the date currently set for hearing and adding April 20, 2009, as the due date for a stipulation.


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1 Counsel for staff has consulted with counsel for Idaho Power CUB regarding this motion
