Pursuant to OAR 860-013-0031, Portland General Electric Company ("PGE") requests that the schedule in this docket be amended. Specifically, PGE requests that the date currently set for Staff and Intervenor testimony, July 1, 2009, be delayed one week to July 8, 2009. The other parties to this docket, Staff of the Oregon Public Utility Commission, the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, and the Citizens' Utility Board, support this motion.

The parties are pursuing settlement of issues in this docket and desire additional time to attempt to come to resolution before testimony is filed. It is anticipated that a one week delay of this testimony filing date will not affect the ability to reach a decision in this docket by the date necessary under PGE's tariff.


**EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION REQUEST**

For the reasons discussed above, PGE requests that the administrative law judge issue an order changing the July 1, 2009, Staff and Intervenor testimony filing date to July

8, 2009. Since the scheduled date is tomorrow, expedited consideration of this motion is requested.
