ChargePoint, Inc. (ChargePoint) respectfully files this Unopposed Motion with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) with two procedural requests related to the upcoming evidentiary hearing in this matter scheduled for October 10 and 11, 2024.

First, ChargePoint requests that Mr. Justin Wilson, Senior Director for Regulatory Policy and Programs at ChargePoint, be permitted to adopt the Opening Testimony of Mal Skowron on Behalf of ChargePoint, Inc., which was prefiled in this docket on July 15, 2024 and premarked as ChargePoint/100. Ms. Skowron is no longer employed by ChargePoint and as a result is unavailable to support her Opening Testimony. Mr. Wilson was Ms. Skowron’s direct supervisor, is familiar with the subject matter and recommendations in ChargePoint/100, and is willing to adopt Ms. Skowron’s testimony in its entirety.

Second, ChargePoint requests that Mr. Wilson be excused from attending the evidentiary hearing in this matter and that ChargePoint/100 be admitted into the record of this proceeding by stipulation. No party has reserved cross examination time for Mr. Wilson.

Counsel for ChargePoint contacted counsel for all other parties in this proceeding on October 2, 2024 requesting their position on the above requests. The following parties stated that they do not oppose ChargePoint’s two requests: Staff, PGE, Verde, AWEC, Walmart, New Sun,

CUB, Calpine Solutions. ChargePoint did not receive a response from any other parties. As a result, this motion is unopposed.

To summarize, ChargePoint respectfully requests that the Commission: 1) allow Mr. Justin Wilson to adopt the Opening Testimony of Ms. Mal Skowron (ChargePoint/100) and 2) allow Mr. Wilson to be excused from attending the hearing and admit his adopted testimony, ChargePoint/100, into the record of this proceeding by stipulation.
