**MOTION TO CORRECT
ORDER NO. 21-001**

1 Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0420, Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade), files this
2 motion requesting that the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) correct Order No.
3 21-001 issued in this docket on January 6, 2021 (the Order) to clarify that the effective date for
4 rates in this case is February 1, 2021.

I. BACKGROUND

5 The Order adopted the First Partial Stipulation, Second Partial Stipulation, and Third
6 Stipulation resolving all issues regarding Cascade's request for a general rate revision made in
7 this docket. Cascade, along with Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff), the
8 Oregon Citizens' Utility Board (CUB), and the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers (AWEC)
9 (collectively the Stipulating Parties) were all parties to these three stipulations.

II. CORRECTION TO THE ORDER

10 On page 1 of the Order, the Commission authorizes a change in rates effective "February
11 1, 2021." However, in Ordering Paragraph 4, on page 18 of the Order, the Commission directs
12 that "Cascade Natural Gas Corporation shall file tariffs consistent with this order with an effective
13 date of January 31, 2021."

14 As reflected in all three Stipulations, the Stipulating Parties had contemplated that the rate

1 effective date would be February 1, 2021.¹ Additionally, Cascade notes that it would be
2 burdensome on the Company’s accounting system to change rates at the end of the month
3 (January 31) rather than the beginning of the following month (February 1). Since there are two
4 different dates in the Order, it appears that the January 31, 2021 date in Ordering Paragraph 4
5 may have been the result of a scrivener’s error. For the foregoing reasons, Cascade respectfully
6 requests that the Commission correct the date provided in Ordering Paragraph 4 on page 18 to
7 be “February 1, 2021.”

8 This requested change does not alter the ratemaking outcome of the Order and no other
9 changes to the Order are requested. Cascade conferred with the other Stipulating Parties, and
10 they support this motion.
