OF OREGON'S MOSTLY UNOPPOSED
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO REFILE A PLEADING

18 Pursuant to OAR 860-013-0031, the American Civil Liberties Union of
19 Oregon ("ACLU") files this Mostly Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to refile
20 its pleading pursuant to the July 31, 2006 Ruling, from August 30, 2006 to
21 September 22, 2006.

22 The ACLU requests this extension because the attorneys for the ACLU, Keith
23 Dubanevich and Mark Friedman, will both be out of town on vacation and to
24 attend a conference for two weeks. In addition, the ACLU intends to explore
25 alternatives to formal proceedings before the PUC and additional time is necessary
26 to complete the research and investigation necessary for the ACLU to file a new

1 pleading as directed by the July 31, 2006 Ruling.

2 Granting an extension to the ACLU will not harm any party to this
3 proceeding and is in the public interest. In addition, the ACLU has conferred with
4 defendants Verizon Northwest Inc. and United Telephone Company of the
5 Northwest, and they have no objection to this request. Counsel for the ACLU
6 attempted to confer with counsel for Qwest Corporation by telephone on August
7 16, 2006 and by e-mail on August 17, 2006, but received no reply as of the date of
8 this filing. The ACLU, therefore, requests that the deadline for the ACLU to refile a
9 pleading be extended to September 22, 2006.


