

1 Under OAR 860-001-0390(2)(b) and 860-001-0420(1), PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific  
2 Power (PacifiCorp or Company) respectfully moves the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) to  
3 grant a one week extension of time to file reply testimony in the above captioned proceeding.

4 In a July 8, 2015, ruling the Administrative Law Judge extended the due date for  
5 response testimony from July 10, 2015 to July 24, 2015. The remainder of the procedural  
6 schedule was not modified, leaving parties with only one week to prepare reply testimony
