MOTION TO CANCEL HEARING  
AND POSTPONE DUE DATE FOR  
PREHEARING BRIEF

9 Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff) informs the Administrative Law  
10 Judge (ALJ) that the following parties, which include all parties filing testimony in this docket,  
11 have agreed to waive cross-examination: Staff, the Oregon Department of Energy, the Citizens'  
12 Utility Board of Oregon, Portland General Electric Company (PGE), PacifiCorp, Idaho Power  
13 Company, NW Sustainable Energy for Economic Development, NW Energy Coalition, Oregon  
14 Solar Energy Industries Association, Renewable Northwest, The Alliance for Solar Choice, and  
15 Environment Oregon. Accordingly, Staff asks the Commission to cancel the hearing that is  
16 scheduled for August 23, 2016.

17 In addition, and even in the event the ALJ does not cancel the hearing, the parties listed  
18 above ask the ALJ to postpone the due date for the "prehearing brief." If the hearing is  
19 cancelled, the parties listed above ask that the due date be moved from August 5 to August 19,  
20 2016. If the hearing is not cancelled, the parties ask that the due date be moved to August 12,  
21 2016.

22 These parties seek postponement of the due date for the prehearing brief even in the event  
23 the hearing is not cancelled because summer vacations and workload have made it difficult for  
24 many of the parties to complete the prehearing brief by August 5, 2016.


25 The other parties to this docket, Obsidian Renewables LLC, Interstate Renewable Energy  
26 Council, Oregonians for Renewable Energy Progress, and the Green Energy Institute were

1 included in e-mails sent to the entire service list on August 1 and 2, 2016, discussing waiving  
2 cross-examination and postponing the due date for the brief. None of these parties indicated that  
3 they object to either proposal.
