MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME
TO FILE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

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9 On April 27, 2017, Administrative Law Judge Harper issued a ruling in this docket
10 rescheduling the hearing and oral argument dates in this proceeding to accommodate
11 Commissioner availability. As a result of the two date changes, other events in the procedural
12 schedule, including Prehearing Briefs, Cross-Examination Statements and Exhibits, Opening
13 Briefs, and Reply Briefs, needed to be adjusted and were left “TBD.” Judge Harper requested
14 that Staff file a proposed schedule establishing dates for these events no later than June 2, 2017.

15 On May 31, 2017, PacifiCorp hosted a settlement conference attended by all parties to
16 this docket. The parties made significant progress toward reaching agreement on the issues in
17 this proceeding, but are currently in the process of drafting a term sheet and discussing a few
18 outstanding issues. As a result, the parties feel that it may be premature to suspend the schedule,
19 but also premature to attempt to find dates for the “TBD” events in the schedule that work for all
20 eight parties when settlement might be reached.

21 Therefore, Staff respectfully requests that the deadline for Staff to file a proposed
22 schedule be postponed by two weeks to June 16, 2017. This approach was discussed at the
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1 settlement conference and supported by all parties to this docket.
