17 By way of background, the Transportation Electrification Plan rules, found at OAR 860-
18 087-0020, require Staff to work with parties to propose a procedural schedule for the review of an
19 electric company’s Transportation Electrification Plan after it is filed.¹ The rules further state that:
20 “The schedule will be adopted by an administrative law judge and will provide an opportunity for
21 written comments by Commission staff and stakeholders, and reply comments by the electric
22 company.”²

23 Portland General Electric (PGE) filed its 2019 Transportation Electrification Plan on
24 September 30, 2019. Staff subsequently drafted a proposed procedural schedule that included the
25 participation elements required by the aforementioned administrative rule. The Administrative



1 Hearings Division (AHD) then circulated the proposed schedule to the UM 2033 service list, as
2 well as UM 1810, UM 1811, and AR 599 service lists. In the email correspondence accompanying
3 the proposed schedule, AHD instructed any party seeking changes to contact the Staff lead for this
4 docket, Eric Shierman. Mr. Shierman did not receive any concerns or proposed changes. To
5 ensure compliance with OAR 860-001-0420(2), Staff circulated this motion to the same service
6 lists indicated above and received no objections. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests that
7 Administrative Law Judge Moser adopt the procedural schedule provided above.
