Good morning Judge Grant,

Regarding your Notice and Memorandum issued in the above referenced docket dated May 27, 2025, PGE would like to request that a procedural conference be set so that PGE and other participating parties can resolve questions regarding the draft order in appendix A and the counterfactual examples in Appendix B prior to working on and providing opening comments. Further, pending the setting of such a conference and assuming that it can be scheduled relatively promptly, PGE would like to request that an approximate three week delay to the procedural schedule be adopted such that opening comments would be due no later than July 17th, with appropriate and similar extensions being granted for the Commissioner Workshop and Reply Comment dates. PGE believes part of the procedural conference could also be spent discussing the modification of the dates with the participating parties given the likely occurrence of vacations or other conflicts during the summer.

Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0420, I emailed all of the parties or organizations on the service list for UM 2273 regarding this request and allowed 48 hours for a response. The parties represented by the respondents in the CC: line above, CUB, RNW, NWECC, CRITFC, NIPPC, GEI, PacifiCorp, AWEC and Sierra Club, all responded with either no opposition or support. I received no comment from any other party represented in the docket including parties that had previously filed briefs in this docket including Pine Gate Renewables, OSSIA, NewSun, and Rogue Climate. I have included the non-responsive parties in the bcc: line of this email such that they continue to be informed of PGE's requests in this docket.
