PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE


*Expedited Consideration Requested*

8           Pursuant to OAR 860-001-0420(2) and OAR 860-001-0420(6), Staff of the Public Utility  
9   Commission of Oregon (Staff) respectfully requests that the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ)  
10   issue a ruling suspending the procedural schedule in this docket to allow opportunity for the  
11   parties to finalize and execute a stipulation. All parties to the proceeding, including Staff, South  
12   Hills Water System, Inc. (South Hills), and each of the four intervenors, have reached a  
13   settlement in principle on all issues in this case. Staff further requests expedited consideration of  
14   this motion, as Staff's testimony is currently due on November 29, 2018. Because a settlement  
15   has been reached, Staff requests that the remaining schedule in this case be suspended. The  
16   parties plan to file a stipulation and supporting testimony before January 4, 2019. Counsel for  
17   Staff has conferred with all parties regarding this motion, and all parties indicated that they  
18   support this motion. Because all parties support the motion, Staff believes no time for response  
19   is necessary.
