PETITION TO INTERVENE OF THE  
ALLIANCE OF WESTERN ENERGY  
CONSUMERS

Pursuant to ORS § 756.525 and OAR § 860-001-0300(2), the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers (“AWEC”) hereby petitions the Oregon Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) to intervene in this proceeding with full party status as described in OAR § 860-001-0010(7). In support of this petition, AWEC represents as follows:

3. AWEC is an incorporated, non-profit association of large energy consumers in the Western United States, with offices in Portland, Oregon. A list of AWEC members is included as Attachment A. Many members of AWEC are customers of PacifiCorp (or the “Company”), as indicated on Attachment A.

4. On December 7, 2018, PacifiCorp filed its request to 1) amortize the 2018 deferred amounts associated with the income tax impact of the Federal Tax Act over two years, beginning on February 1, 2019; 2) apply the Tax Act’s impact on current income tax expense and unprotected excess deferred income tax (“EDIT”) balances to the net book value of its coal assets; and 3) continue to defer the Tax Act’s impact to protected EDIT, and to begin amortization of these amounts over five years beginning in 2021. If approved by the Commission, the Company’s proposals will substantially and directly affect those of AWEC’s members who purchase power from PacifiCorp. AWEC therefore requests leave to intervene in this Docket to represent its members who are affected by any change to PacifiCorp’s rates and programs.

5. AWEC represents the interests of a number of large customers served by PacifiCorp in Oregon. AWEC also has significant experience participating in proceedings involving PacifiCorp’s rates. AWEC’s intervention in this proceeding will assist the Commission in resolving the issues in this proceeding and will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay this proceeding.

6. As described above, AWEC has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by

any Commission determination made in connection with this proceeding. It is in the public interest to allow AWEC to intervene in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, AWEC respectfully requests that the Commission grant its petition to intervene with full party status in this proceeding.
