4. The nature and extent of the Petitioner's interest in the proceeding is:

In pursuit of our mission to decarbonize the Northwest, we actively participate in proceedings and discussions related to renewable resource interconnection. We were active participants in PacifiCorp's application to FERC for Open Access Transmission Tariff revisions related to the transition from serial to cluster queue processing, and we have addressed interconnection-related issues in PacifiCorp's 2020 All-Source RFP (UM 2059) and 2022 All-Source RFP (UM 2193) dockets. We have also participated in interconnection-related processes in other states.

5. The issues the Petitioner intends to raise at the proceeding are:

Renewable Northwest intends to participate as a party and raise issues that are appropriate to the proceeding.

6. The special knowledge or expertise of the Petitioner that would assist the Commission in resolving the issues in the proceeding is:
