In accordance with OAR 860-039-0055(2), PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power and Mr. Gary Graham, a net metering customer, have agreed to a new 12-month annualized billing period. OAR 860-039-0055(2) requires the annual billing cycle for net metering customers end at the end of the March billing cycle each year, unless the utility and net metering customer agree to a different annual billing cycle. This section also requires the utility to notify the Oregon Public Utility Commission within 30 days reaching an agreement for a different annualized billing cycle. PacifiCorp and Mr. Gary Graham reached agreement for a new annualized billing cycle on February 4, 2013. The new annualized billing cycle for Mr. Graham will end with the April billing period of each year.

This mutual agreement to reset your annualized billing period modifies any existing agreement in reference to the annualize billing period. All other provisions remain in full effect.


