Pursuant to ORS 757.259(3); ORS 757.072; OAR 860-027-0300; and Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission or OPUC) Order Nos. 03-388, 18-017, and 21-069, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) hereby respectfully supplements its request for reauthorization to defer intervenor funding costs.

**I. Deferral Status**

On August 11, 2003, PGE filed its initial request to defer the costs and revenues associated with the intervenor funding. On May 20, 2004, PGE filed its first request to reauthorize the deferral. On June 29, 2021, PGE filed its most recent request to reauthorize the deferral, which was approved by Commission Order No. 21-255. PGE proposes to update the previous UM 1103 application to include additional information as provided in Section 3 of House Bill 2475, which amends ORS 757.072.

Proposed Modifications:

- Financial assistance may be provided to not only the broad interests of customers, but also to the interests of low-income residential customers and/or the interest of residential customers that are members of environmental justice communities.

- The total aggregate financial assistance to all organizations that represent low-income residential customers and/or residential customers that are members of environmental justice communities will not exceed \$500,000 annually.
- PGE will provide an agreement that includes the provision of financial assistance to the aforementioned organizations. PGE understands that any agreement must be approved by the Commission prior to providing financial assistance.

A copy of the Notice of Supplement to Application for Reauthorization to Defer Intervenor Funding Costs and a list of the persons served with the notice are attached to the application as Attachment A.

## **II. Conclusion**

For the reasons stated in the June 29, 2021 application and with the above-noted modifications, PGE requests that the Commission issue an order granting its reauthorization request to defer the costs associated with intervenor funding.
