SIERRA CLUB’S REPLY BRIEF RE
MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE MATTERS;
MOTION REQUESTING ORAL ARGUMENT
FOR CHALLENGE OF DESIGNATION; and
REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED REVIEW

PacifiCorp bases its opposition to consolidation on two points: (1) Chief Grant previously characterized the issues of alleged breach and of designation of confidential information as “separate and distinct”; and, (2) the burden of proof is different for the two issues. Sierra Club does not dispute either of these points, but neither do these points demonstrate that consolidation is not appropriate.

Chief Grant stated during the August 18, 2014 prehearing meeting that Sierra Club will be able to “explain and defend [its] actions” and explain why its actions did not “constitute[] a violation of the protective order... ” and why sanctions should not be imposed.¹ Sierra Club’s Motion to Consolidate asserts that, although the questions and burdens of proof may be separate and distinct, the questions of whether a violation occurred and whether sanctions are appropriate are linked at least in part to the designation of confidential materials. Sierra Club will not reiterate the points of its motion here other than to say that consolidation of the issues is

necessary to allow Sierra Club a full and fair opportunity to “explain and defend” its actions to the Commission. The Commission can consider the two issues at once despite separate burdens of proof.
