On May 5, 2026, PacifiCorp dba Pacific Power (PacifiCorp) filed a request for a general rate increase. The Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) will hold a public comment hearing on PacifiCorp's request, as follows:

The public comment hearing will convene at 6:00 p.m. and remain open until at least 7:00 p.m. If there are members of the public still waiting to offer comment at 7:00 p.m., the public comment hearing may continue to allow as many members of the public to comment as time permits.

The Public Comment Hearing is an opportunity for customers and members of the public to offer unsworn testimony to the Commissioners and Administrative Law Judge. This event is being noticed as a Public Meeting because at least two Commissioners are planning to attend. The event will begin with a brief presentation from Staff to explain the rate case process. Because the purpose of this hearing is to take comments from the public, PacifiCorp and the other parties to the proceeding will not make formal presentations and the Commissioners will not take questions. The public comment hearing will be recorded and transcribed. The transcript will become part of the public comment record in the proceeding.

Any comments received by October 15, 2026, will be summarized and included in Staff's rebuttal testimony. Comments filed after October 15, 2026, will be posted to the docket and reviewed, but will not be included with Staff testimony.¹
