RULING

DISPOSITION: COMMENT DEADLINE EXTENDED

On April 7, 2022, a rulemaking hearing was held regarding the Division 300 Public Safety Power Shutoffs. At the hearing, the Oregon Joint Use Association (OJUA) indicated that it intends to file comments with redlines by the close of the comment period published in the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking Hearing was issued on February 25, 2022. Extending the deadline will allow other participants time to file any responsive comments, and review AHD's final rule recommendation. The comment deadline is extended to 3:00 p.m. on April 12, 2022. The Commission's consideration of these proposed rules remains scheduled for the April 19, 2022 Public Meeting (Commission deliberation only, no public comment).
