RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On February 17, 2022, AWEC filed a motion to allow Curt R. Ledford to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The affidavit of Curt R. Ledford accompanied the motion. Mr. Ledford states that he will associate with Corinne O. Milinovich, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Curt R. Ledford as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of AWEC is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
