RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION GRANTED


During a prehearing conference held in this docket on March 1, 2010, Daniel Meek, attorney for Nancy Peyron, moved for a contested case. The Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) asked Mr. Meek to put the motion in writing. Idaho Power Company (Idaho Power) and Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff) requested expedited consideration of the motion; no party participating in the conference objected. The parties agreed that the motion for a contested case would be filed by March 2, 2010, responses would be filed by March 9, and replies in support of the motion would be due March 12. In compliance with this schedule, Mr. Meek filed a motion for a contested case on behalf of Move Idaho Power and Nancy Peyron on March 2, 2010.

On March 5, 2010, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed a motion for an extension of time to respond to the motion for a contested case. PGE did not participate in the March 1 prehearing conference. Because Idaho Power and Staff requested expedited consideration of the motion for a contested case, the ALJ gave them the opportunity to object to the request for an extension by electronic mail before 2:00 p.m. on March 8, 2010. Neither Idaho Power nor Staff objected to the request for an extension.

PGE's motion for an extension to respond to Move Idaho Power and Nancy Peyron's motion for a contested case is granted. Responses to the motion for a contested case are due March 16, 2010. Move Idaho Power and Nancy Peyron may file a reply to the responses by March 26, 2010.

On March 8, 2010, PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power, also filed a motion asking that the due date for responding to the motion for a contested case be changed to March 16, 2010. Because PGE's motion is granted, Pacific Power's motion is moot.
