RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE*
GRANTED

On February 16, 2016, Sierra Club filed a motion to allow Gloria D. Smith and Travis Ritchie to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. Ms. Smith and Mr. Ritchie state that they will associate with Joshua Smith, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Gloria D. Smith and Travis Ritchie as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Sierra Club is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
