RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE*
GRANTED

On December 22, 2016, Invenergy, LLC filed a motion to allow Jeffrey D. Jeep to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. On December 30, 2016 Invenergy filed a supporting affidavit of Jeffrey D. Jeep stating that he will associate with John W. Weil, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and supporting documents and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320.

The motion to admit Jeffrey D. Jeep as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Invenergy, LLC is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
