RULING

DISPOSITION: PETITION TO INTERVENE GRANTED FOR LIMITED
PURPOSES

Petitions to Intervene were filed by Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU); NW Energy Coalition (NWEC); Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition (NIPPC); and Renewable Northwest (Renewable NW). Although a proceeding to review a utility's integrated resource plan (IRP) is not considered a contested case proceeding under ORS 183.310(2), the Commission grants petitions to intervenes for the limited purposes of: 1) creating a service list; and 2) establishing eligibility to sign a protective order.

The petitions to intervene, filed by ICNU, NWEC, NIPPC, and Renewable NW are granted for the limited purposes described above.
