MEMORANDUM REGARDING
SPECIAL PUBLIC MEETINGS

As set forth in the June 3, 2022 memorandum issued in this docket, the Commission will hold a Special Public Meeting to hear final Staff, company, and public comments on Idaho Power Company's 2021 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) on November 29, 2022, and a Special Public Meeting to finalize its decision on acknowledgment on December 6, 2022. The agenda for each meeting is outlined below.

November 29, 2022 Special Public Meeting for Final Public Comment (1:30 p.m.)

- Welcome and Commissioner remarks
- Staff recommendations on the IRP
- Idaho Power Company's comments
- Stakeholder and public comments

The PUC requests that members of the public wishing to provide oral comment on Staff's recommendations and Idaho Power Company's 2021 IRP notify the PUC at least 24 hours before the meeting. Prior notice is not required, but it helps the PUC manage time for public comment and makes it more likely that all comments can be heard. At the appropriate time, the Chair will take comments from those who have made requests to speak in advance, and if time permits, from those indicating an interest to comment during the meeting. December 6, 2022 Special Public Meeting for Decision on Acknowledgment (1:30 p.m.)

The Commission will make a decision regarding whether to acknowledge Idaho Power Company's 2021 IRP. The Commission will not accept comment from the company, stakeholders, or the public at this meeting but may ask specific follow-up questions to Staff, the company, or other participants in attendance.
