MEMORANDUM

On April 10, 2023, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon held a procedural conference. Representatives appeared on behalf of Portland General Electric Company; Oregon Citizens' Utility Board; Alliance of Western Energy Consumers; Northwest & Intermountain Power Producers Coalition; NewSun Energy, LLC; Renewable Energy Coalition; Renewable Northwest, LLC; Northwest Natural Gas Company; and Commission Staff. Staff submitted a proposed procedural schedule ahead of the conference.

Procedural Schedule

During the conference, Staff and participant representatives engaged in a collective discussion regarding potential modifications to the proposed schedule. Representatives of the attending organizations conferred off the record. After conferring, all attendees noted agreement with the following schedule. Persons may seek party status, however, for the limited purpose of obtaining access to confidential information pursuant to the terms of a protective order. Party status in this proceeding, however, does not confer the general rights and duties as those of parties in contested case proceedings.
