RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On October 26, 2023, Idaho Power Company filed a motion to allow Megan Goicoechea Allen to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in these proceedings. The affidavit of Megan Goicoechea Allen accompanied the motion. Megan Goicoechea Allen states that she will associate with Jocelyn Pease, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motions for admission *pro hac vice* and find that they comply with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Megan Goicoechea Allen as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Idaho Power Company is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
