MEMORANDUM ESTABLISHING
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On September 29, 2023, Idaho Power Company, filed its 2023 Integrated Resource Plan. On October 30, 2023, I issued a memorandum in these proceedings directing Idaho Power Company, the Staff of the Public Utility Commission, the Oregon Citizens Utility Board, the Renewable Energy Coalition, and any other entity that had expressed interest in participating in these proceedings to confer and jointly propose a schedule in lieu of holding a prehearing conference.

On November 8, 2023, Staff filed a proposed procedural schedule. Staff states that it circulated the proposed schedule to the service list and that it did not receive any objections or requests for modifications. On November 9, 2023, Staff filed a modified proposed schedule that changed the date for Commission Workshop No. 1 from March 26, 2024, to April 2, 2024. No participating entity or interested persons requested a prehearing conference.

I find that the procedural schedule proposed by Staff is reasonable. Accordingly, the procedural schedule is adopted as set forth below:

the process set forth in OAR 860-027-0400. Persons need not intervene as a party in order to participate in this proceeding, and may attend workshops, submit written comments, and provide oral comments to the Commission at public comment meetings. Persons may seek party status, however, for the limited purpose of obtaining access to confidential information pursuant to the terms of a protective order. Party status in this proceeding, however, does not confer the general rights and duties as those of parties in contested case proceedings.
