**MEMORANDUM AND AGENDA FOR
THE JULY 23 AND 30, 2024 SPECIAL
PUBLIC MEETINGS**

As set forth in the November 13, 2023 memorandum establishing a schedule issued in this docket, the Commission will hold a Special Public Meeting to hear final Staff, company, and public comments on Idaho Power Company's 2023 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) on July 23, 2024. Additionally, the Commission has reserved time on July 30, 2024, for a Special Public Meeting to deliberate on acknowledgment to the extent that there is not enough time to reach a decision at the earlier meeting. The agenda for each meeting is outlined below.

July 23, 2024 Special Public Meeting for Final Public Comment (1:30 p.m.)

- Welcome and Commissioner remarks
- Staff recommendations on the IRP
- Idaho Power comments
- Stakeholder and public comments
- Commissioner Questions and Discussion

The Commission requests that members of the public wishing to provide oral comment on Staff's recommendations and Idaho Power's 2023 IRP notify the Commission at least 24 hours before the meeting. Prior notice is not required, but it helps the Commission manage time for public comment and makes it more likely that all comments can be heard. At the appropriate time, the Chair will take comments from those who have made requests to speak in advance, and if time permits, from those indicating an interest to comment during the meeting. The Commission may set time limits for each speaker depending on the number of people interested in providing comment. If you would like to comment, please send an email to the Commission at puc.publicmeetings@puc.oregon.gov and provide your name, who you're representing, and what issue you would like to comment on.

July 30, 2024 Special Public Meeting for Decision on Acknowledgment (1:30 p.m.)

This Special Public Meeting will only be held to the extent that the Commission does not make a decision on acknowledgment at the July 23, 2024 Special Public Meeting. If this meeting is held, the Commission will make a decision regarding whether to acknowledge,

and the Commission will not accept comment from the company, stakeholders, or the public at this meeting. The Commission may, however, ask specific follow-up questions to Staff, the company, or other participants in attendance.
