RULING

**DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE MODIFIED**

On March 6, 2023, nine intervenors<sup>1</sup> jointly filed a motion to extend the deadline for cross-answering and rebuttal testimony and amend the remaining procedural schedule in this matter. On March 9, 2023, I granted that motion in part and modified the procedural schedule. On March 9, 2023, Idaho Power filed a motion requesting I extend its deadline for its surrebuttal testimony to April 7, 2023. I find good cause to grant the motion.
