MEMORANDUM

This memo serves to notify the parties that after an initial review, I have determined that certain portions of Greg Larkin's opening brief constitute legal argument. The Oregon APA and the Commission's rules prohibit self-represented litigants from making legal argument, including when a self-represented litigant has an authorized representative.¹

As such, the portions of Mr. Larkin's opening brief on pages 23-25 regarding United States Supreme Court case law will not be considered in the Commission's review of Idaho Power's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity petition.
