

MEMORANDUM

On November 29, 2022, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon will hold a Special Public Meeting to hear final Staff, company, and public comments on Idaho Power Company's 2021 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP). On December 6, 2022, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon will hold a Special Public Meeting to finalize its decision on acknowledgment of Idaho Power's 2021 IRP. Any comments regarding the Idaho Power 2021 IRP should be filed in docket LC 78 and/or provided at the November 29, 2022, Special Public Meeting. Such comments should relate to the content of the 2021 IRP. Any comments regarding Idaho Power's Petition for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) or the siting of the proposed Boardman to Hemingway transmission line should be filed in docket PCN 5 or provided at the December 5, 2022, public comment hearing.
