RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AMENDED

On November 18, 2025, PacifiCorp filed a motion to modify the procedural schedule in this docket. The motion explains that the company and Commission Staff have reached an agreement allowing more time for Staff to respond to certain PacifiCorp data requests, for the company to have the opportunity to include the responses as stipulated exhibits, and to reflect PacifiCorp and Staff's agreement to waive cross-examination of witnesses in this docket. The motion also requests direction regarding whether the hearing will be canceled and whether the parties should still file the Joint Issues List and Position Statements if the hearing were to be canceled. The motion proposes amendments to the procedural schedule, asks for expedited consideration, and notes that Staff supports the motion.


Based on the representations in PacifiCorp's motion, I grant it and the procedural schedule is amended as shown in bold below. I am likely to cancel the December 2-3, 2025 hearing, however, to assist me in making a final decision regarding cancellation, I would still like the parties to submit a Joint Issues List. Position statements are no longer required and have been removed from the procedural schedule.
